The Principal Party in Interest further understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent statements or for the violation of any U.S. laws or regulations regarding the transportation or exportation of goods, and agrees to be bound by all filings made by the Authorized Agent based on the information or documentation provided.

The Principal Party in Interest certifies that all necessary export control classifications, license determinations, and other applicable export compliance steps have been or will be taken prior to export.

The Authorized Agent shall not be held liable for any errors, penalties, or delays resulting from incorrect, incomplete, or untimely information provided by the Principal Party in Interest. The Principal Party in Interest acknowledges full responsibility for the accuracy and completeness of all data provided in support of electronic export filings.

The Principal Party in Interest agrees to maintain copies of this authorization and all supporting documentation for a minimum of five (5) years, as required by 15 CFR Part 30 and 19 CFR Part 192.

This authorization shall remain in effect until revoked in writing or superseded.
